

PRIVACY POLICY

At Vine Publishing Ltd we take the security of your data very seriously and do all that we can to ensure that we conform to the laws and best practice of the industry. This document lays down how we will use any personal data that we may collect and your rights to view or amend it.

1. WHAT INFORMATION WILL WE COLLECT

We may keep any information that you provide when you fill in any forms on our website or when you contact us, plus we may keep details of any transactions that you carry out through our system, details of your visit to our website and the details of resources that you access using our website.

2. IP ADDRESSES AND COOKIES

3. IF WE USE YOUR INFORMATION, HOW WILL WE USE IT?

vinedigital.co.uk is the sole owner of the information collected from vinedigital.co.uk. vinedigital.co.uk collects personally identifiable information from our users at several different points on our website. vinedigital.co.uk collects demographic (information about you, such as name and address) and answers to specific questions asked by vinedigital.co.uk, its clients or sponsors. This data is used by vinedigital.co.uk and carefully selected third parties to send you by, email, voice, post or other appropriate means, communications about their products or services. We may use any of this information in the following ways: to make sure that the content that you see from our website is presented to you and your computer in an effective manner, to provide you with products, information, services or special offers that we feel may be of interest to you or that you have requested from our website, where you have shown consent to be contacted for such purposes; to confirm the accuracy of the information that we hold about you via third party providers of such services, to include phone, e-mail, and postal verification methods, to inform you about the changes and upcoming services through our website.
